John Bowlby as a secure base

Speaker: Arturo Ezquerro*

A conjoint project, part of a developing collaboration between the Bowlby Centre (BC), the Institute of Group Analysis (IGA), Supporting Relationships and Families (SRF) and the International Attachment Network (IAN). Our goal is to promote attachment-based thinking and practice, as widely as possible.

The workshop will be chaired by **Desmond King**, of the Executive Committee of IAN. The large group will be convened by **Desmond King** and **Maria Canete** (IGA group analyst).

Some of us, loyal to attachment principles, might imagine to be protected from the infighting, rivalries and ruptures that affect psychotherapists, counsellors and mental health professionals by and large. This wishful-thinking may in turn lead to disappointment...

Based on the speaker's experience of supervision and mentorship with John Bowlby, this workshop will aim to offer opportunities to explore, and reflect upon, possible ways of forming an 'attachment' with Bowlby; so as to perceive him and his legacy as a compass and a secure base, from which to navigate through the troubled waters of our caring professions and institutions.
